What type of plugs are used in Russia?

Russia uses Type C electrical outlets with standard voltage of 220V and 50Hz frequency. If your device plugs don't match Russia's standards, we recommend purchasing suitable travel adapters in advance to ensure proper use. What power plug types are used in Russia? Type C plugs consist of two round pins and have no grounding.

Are there electrical outlets in Russia?

No, the electrical outlets in Russia are different from those in the United States. In Russia electrical outlets of types C & F are used, while the United States has electrical outlets of types A & B. Do I need a travel adapter for Russia? The electrical outlets and power plugs in Russia are of types C & F (see images).

Do I need a travel adapter in Russia?

The electrical outlets and power plugs in Russia are of types C & F (see images). If your country uses the same electrical outlets and power plugs, you don't need a travel adapter. However, you may still need a voltage converter if the voltage is different.

Which power plugs are used in Moscow?

In Moscow power plugs and electrical outlets of types C & F are used: If you're not sure whether the outlets and plugs used in your country are the same as in Moscow, you can use the tool at the top of this page to check if you need a travel adapter.

What voltage does Russia use?

Russia operates on a 220V supply voltage and 50Hz. The power plugs and sockets are of type C and F. If your devices are not compatible with these plug types or voltage, it is advisable to carry a universal travel adapter or a voltage converter.

Do I need a travel adapter for a Russian Charger?

However, it is possible you'll need an adapter to plug the charger into a Russia outlet. Russia uses electrical outlets and power plugs of types C & F (see images).
